1. AQAR Preparation for the year 2018-19

The committee decided to initiate data collection for submitting AQAR 2018-19. It was decided to constitute a Faculty Quality Circle (FQC) for completing the work. The FQC consist of a coordinator and three to four members for each of the 7 criteria. A central documentation committee shall also be constituted. The IQAC and NAAC Coordinator shall convene meeting separately for each FQC team. The FQC for each criterion shall then meet separately and chalk out measures for collecting data.

2. Action plan to be taken for qualitative improvement based on 7 criteria.

The committee decided to entrust the FQC for framing specific action plan for data collection in connection with AQAR 2018-19 and AQAR 2019-20. A central documentation committee for digitization of data also shall also be constituted.

3. Constitution of an Internal team for the preparation for NAAC accreditation 2024

The FQC shall be act as an internal team for the preparation of NAAC accreditation 2024. This shall be done after uploading AQAR 2018-19 and 2019-20 before the stipulated date.

4. Any other item permitted by the chair.

The IQAC shall formulate a specific scientific project for collection of solid and liquid waste its disposal. It shall recommend the management for initiating immediate action plan in this regard. Tie up with external agencies for waste management was also suggested.

The meeting came to a close at 4.30pm.
